## Descriptive Video Service

DVS (Descriptive Video Service) Home Videos are designed for persons who are blind or who have low vision. These videos carefully describe the visual elements of a movie - the action, characters, locations, costumes and sets - without interfering with the movie's dialogue or sound effects.

To hear the audio descriptions on these videos, only a regular videocassette player and a television are needed. No other special feature or device is needed. Every video also is closed-captioned for deaf and hard-of-hearing individuals whose televisions are equipped with that feature.

Public showing of these videos is allowed only under the condition that no admission is charged, nor donations solicited.

Patrons of the Kansas Talking Book Service also have access to a larger collection (including descriptive DVD's) through the State Library of Kansas Talking Books Service in Emporia.
