Do your residents qualify for *free* Talking Books?

Anyone who is unable to read standard size print, due to a visual or physical impairment, is eligible for the free Talking Books program. For example, someone who is unable to turn the pages of a book due to muscle weakness or a physical disability could qualify for the Talking Books program. People who are blind or have visual impairments such as macular degeneration or diabetic retinopathy would also qualify.
