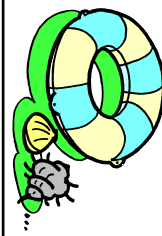

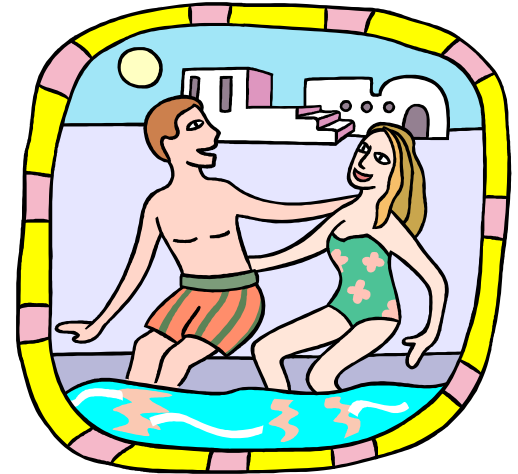

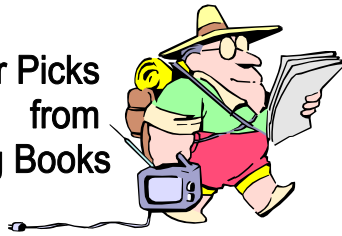

RC 57410 *Blue Plate Specials and Blue Ribbon Chefs: The Heart and Soul of America's Great Roadside Restaurants* by Jane Stern and Michael Stern. Celebrated food writers travel across the country to find the tastiest dishes America's blue-collar chefs have to offer. 2001.

RC 57739 *As the Towers Fell: Stories of Unshakable Faith on 9-11* by Lisa Chilson-Rose. The personal stories of twenty-four Christians who experienced the terrorist attacks on New York City on September 11, 2001. 2003.

RC 58005 *I Am What I Ate . . . and I'm Frightened!!! And Other Digressions from the Doctor of Comedy* by Bill Cosby. Realizing that he is what he eats, Cosby reflects back on his 65 years of dining and the quest for a healthy lifestyle. Bestseller 2003.

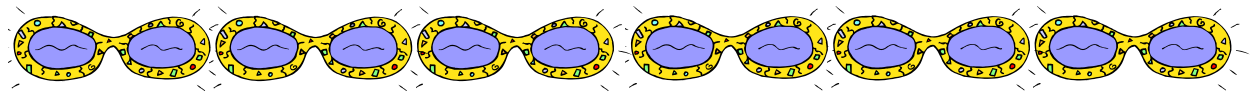

RC 57977 *Rumpole and the Primrose Path* by John Mortimer. Six stories featuring British barrister Rumpole. 2002.

RC 58266 *Fudge Cupcake Murder: A Hannah Swensen Mystery* by Joanne Fluke. After teaching a cooking class Minnesota baker Hanna empties the trash and discovers Sheriff Grant's body in a dumpster. 2004.
