Do YOUR residents qualify for free Talking Books?

Anyone who is unable to read standard size print, due to a visual or physical impairment, may be eligible for the free Talking Books program. Someone who is unable to turn the pages of a book due to a physical disability could qualify for the Talking Books program.

People who are blind or have visual impairments such as macular degeneration would also qualify. If some of your residents are eligible for this free service, please contact Jaime ASAP.
